Behaviour for Learning levels which appear on school reports to parents

Level 1 OUTSTANDING BfL

Outstanding BfL students **always** invest in their own learning. They:

- hand homework in on time
- do reading / research homework
- have their coursework / classwork up to date
- bring the appropriate equipment
- listen carefully to staff and students
- stay on task and maintain an excellent workrate
- make a good contribution to group work and to whole class discussions
- are on time to lessons ready to learn
- meet targets whenever possible
- follow the classroom code of conduct
- wear school uniform with pride

You do everything expected of you and consistently invest in your learning; you are a role model for other students

Level 2 GOOD BfL

Good BfL students **almost always** invest in their own learning. They:

- hand homework in on time
- do reading / research homework
- have their coursework / classwork up to date
- bring the appropriate equipment
- listen carefully to staff and students
- stay on task
- make a good contribution to group work and to whole class discussions
- are on time to lessons ready to learn
- meet targets whenever possible
- follow the classroom code of conduct
- wear school uniform with pride

You show that you want to learn

Level 3 SATISFACTORY BfL

Satisfactory BfL students are likely to be **neglecting** some aspects of their learning and / or are inconsistent in their approach. At their best, they are able to make progress.

Sometimes they don't:

- complete homework or hand it in on time
- do reading / research homework
- have their coursework / classwork up to date
- bring the appropriate equipment
- listen carefully to staff and students
- stay on task or concentrate
- work well with others
- turn up on time ready to learn
- meet targets whenever possible
- follow the classroom code of conduct
- wear school uniform with pride

You are preventing yourself from doing as well as you can. You can do much better than this. You need to invest in your own learning.

Level 4 INADEQUATE BfL

Inadequate BfL students are able to do so much better but are under-achieving and giving cause for concern. They have **difficulties in managing their own learning** and stop other students learning.

They:

- do little or no homework or coursework
- disrupt learning
- are uncooperative with staff and students
- do not do as asked or told without argument or question
- are late to lessons and/or arrive without appropriate equipment
- do not respond to being on report
- do not improve despite the help we have offered
- do not meet targets
- do not make an appropriate effort
- do not make the right learning or behaviour choices

You are so much better than you are prepared to demonstrate. You can turn things around with correct choices and investment in your own learning. Serious consequences will follow unless you make more appropriate choices.
